The Festival Volunteer Director administers all aspects of the festival's volunteer program including recruiting, training, and supervising volunteers.

Duties/ Responsibilities:

- Communicates with festival management to identify available opportunities and needs for volunteers.
- Recruits volunteer staff.
- Gathers information about each volunteer's skills and availability; matches volunteers with appropriate opportunities.
- Schedules volunteers with assigned opportunities.
- Maintains volunteer application and records for the volunteer program.
- Drafts, maintains, and publishes guidelines, best practices, and procedures for volunteer program.
- Coordinates volunteer recognition and appreciation events and activities.

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Strong leadership skills with ability to motivate and encourage others.
- Proficient with Microsoft Office Suite or related software.
